BARBARA STOLER MILLER

- Renowned Indologist widely credited with awakening Western interest in Indic texts
- o B.A. from Barnard, M.A. from Columbia, PhD from UPenn
- Went back to Columbia to help guide Southern Asian Institute and translate more Sanskrit works
- Best known for her translation of the Bhagavad Gita

BILHANA

- 11th-century poet who likely lived in Kashmir
- Caurapancasika (The Love Thief) is his best known work
- The poems were orally transmitted across the subcontinent, and only were recovered due to a series of paintings visualizing the verse
